


Raw Honey Drum Labels

Incomplete or unreadable markings on drums of raw honey received from producers are a significant problem for honey packers. Each drum of honey, when it reaches our receiving dock, must be easily referenced to the Purchase Order for the honey. This requires that each drum lid or top bear the name of the producer, the Lot # of the honey, and a unique number. This information should be summarized by Lot # and be directly related to the Sample # that appears on the Purchase Order.

Barkman Honey, LLC has developed this generic label for producers to clearly mark drums of honey at extraction time. We believe this may assist producers in separating drum #s into specific Lots directly related to marked honey samples. It will improve the efficiency and accuracy in processing your honey if our warehouse staff can easily read a completed Raw Honey label on the top of the drum. If a drum is clearly numbered, packers can trace and discuss load sample results more specifically with producers.

These labels have been tested for readability after going through a drum washer, marked with any of the following: ball point pen, permanent marker, and a grease pencil. But the intent is that a new label will be used for each drum use.

Barkman Honey, LLC encourages you to add this tool to your honey marking and accounting systems. We believe it can assist the industry in its ongoing quest for higher quality and efficiency.
